Introduction

The objective of this newsletter is to provide information about the activities executed since our visit to Yawsae in November 2010. During this visit we have seen that the newly build classrooms were fully operational and have confirmed the future requirements to improve education, general well being and health with the chief of the community, the headmaster and our local project manager. We have also visited the local education authorities to inform them about the progress of our projects and future plans. As a result of a meeting with the teachers we have purchased teaching and learning materials and toys.



1. Well

Near Yawsae is a well, which is being used by 7 hamlets. This well was polluted and therefore we have renovated and repaired it in order to enable the inhabitants to use it again. Our project manager will facilitate the maintenance and the purification of the water. Every 3 months the water will be disinfected with tablets. By means of a jerry can the water will be collected.
